



Costa Ricans, who call themselves Ticos (an expression that comes from their tendency to add a diminutive suffix, either "tico" or "ito" at the end of words to connote familiarity or affection) are a friendly and outgoing people.

Programs

## Methodology

Our programs offer students the opportunity to learn Spanish and to discover our culture first-hand.

#### These programs include:

Intensive Spanish classes, homestays with Costa Rican families, afternoon cultural classes (Latin dance, cooking, conversation), and 24 hour airport transfers.

#### OPEN ENROLLMENT:

Spanish courses are offered year round. New classes start on Mondays, every week of the year.

### SHORT & LONG TERM COURSES:

Students may choose the length of the program (from one week up to six months).

#### HOURS OF INSTRUCTION:

We offer diverse programs and schedules. Students may select from 3 to 6 hours of Spanish instruction per day and also combine group classes with private tutoring.

#### SMALL GROUPS:

Spanish classes are offered in small groups with an average of 3-4 students (max. 6). Individual classes and special packages for groups are also available. and fun to do is it possible to learn quickly and easily. Consequently, the essence of our courses is a varied and dynamic teaching approach. Our aim is to teach classes that are intensive, yet challenging and enjoyable.

ur methodology calls for active participation from our students.

CRLA's practical courses enable the students to communicate, comprehend and use accurate pronunciation in Spanish as quickly as possible.

All our classes emphasize speaking abilities, but we consider the Spanish language as a whole; therefore, our programs take into account: grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, cultural understanding and pragmatic use.

Our Spanish classes usually consist of 3 to 4 students - never more than six. This small class size, along with our student - oriented teaching philosophy, provide the ideal setting for instructors to adapt the methodology and approach to meet student's individual needs and learning styles.

tudents will be placed in classes according to their Spanish proficiency level, which is determined by a written test sent by email and an oral evaluation exam before starting the course. The level will be confirmed by each instructor based on the student's performance during the class.

hroughout the course, progress will be assessed daily by the teacher and our Academic Director. Every day, instructors hand in a progress report for each student in the class. This information helps our Academic Director determine and decide, along with the student, the best way for reaching his/her language goals.

## Spanish Courses

We provide ten levels of Spanish instruction:

Beginners I, II & III

Advanced I, II & III

Intermediate I, II & III

Specialized courses

#### Beginner Levels

Beginner's courses I, II and III have been designed to provide an introduction to elementary Spanish. The primary objective of these courses is to offer students the opportunity to acquire communication skills in what we call "Survival Spanish". Topics include: asking/giving directions, using appropriate greetings, introductions and courtesy expressions as well as being able to communicate in different situations such as visiting a bank, restaurant, or other public places. Furthermore, students should be able to give their personal information, and talk about personal preferences and activities in increasing detail.

Beginner students will study basic sentence structures, learn everyday vocabulary and develop the ability to clearly communicate basic ideas in Spanish.

#### Intermediate Levels

The intermediate course is divided into Intermediate I, II & III and covers most grammatical structures, which will give students the tools needed to achieve more confidence and fluency when using the language. Students will learn the main grammatical structures, while improving vocabulary, pronunciation, comprehension, as well as written and oral skills. At this level the students learn to use different compensation strategies to communicate their ideas when they do not know the exact structure or word that should be used. Students will also be able to hold conversations on various topics with native Spanish speakers, using the appropriate grammatical forms for each situation.

This course emphasizes on cultural aspects of the language and its real usage. The emphasis is on culturally authentic reading and writing, along with continued development of listening/speaking competencies.

#### Advanced Levels

This course includes the study of advanced Spanish grammar. Students should begin to master complex syntactical and morphological structures and special differences used in the language. In addition, the students will have the opportunity to discuss current topics and have conversations with a higher level of complexity and abstract content in order to improve considerably in fluency and precision. This level includes cultural, social and historical aspects on different Hispanic speaking countries as a way to explain the relationship between language, history and culture. The objective of this course is to achieve a high level of proficiency and fluency in the Spanish language. Furthermore, emphasis is placed on the comprehension and use of the language in unrehearsed situations in culturally appropriate ways.

#### Specialized Spanish Courses

We also offer medical Spanish for nurses or doctors, Spanish for lawyers, business Spanish, and special courses for Spanish teachers, as well as Latin American Literature courses.

#### Spanish Course for Spanish Language Teachers.

For Spanish language teachers or those studying for this profession, we offer private courses providing additional training. We discuss Latin American history and literature, focusing on textual and advanced grammatical analysis, composition and literary style. A participant may select the area in which he/she would like to specialize. Our Spanish Language Coordinator will work closely with him/her to develop a personalized program.

#### Spanish Language Course for Medical Professionals

This course is designed for health-care professionals who need to communicate with Spanish-speaking patients and their families as part of their daily work. It caters to various types of medical personnel including doctors, medical students, nurses, paramedics and can be adapted to each student's specific needs. This specialized course is offered as a supplement to our general Spanish language curriculum and is individually adapted to each student's level. Together, these courses facilitate effective communication between provider and patient within the health care setting.

Materials used were developed with the help of medical professionals with ample experience, in order to allow students to become familiar with the Spanish medical vocabulary and have the necessary tools to work with patients, explain or discuss various medical topics, and also act as an interpreter, if required. Visits to local clinics & hospitals are scheduled to complement the course.



#### Materials

In accordance with our teaching experience and specific needs of our students, we have produced our own original student workbooks which integrate the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing, using Costa Rican cultural and social content. Additional teaching materials include games, charts, flashcards, audio tapes and others.

Our program emphasizes the development of oral competence and fluency in Spanish.






## Spanish Instructors

CRLA has a permanent teaching staff of 25 native Spanish-speaking instructors. During the high season our staff increases to 35-40 teachers in order to ensure small groups and personalized attention.



Homestays are an excellent way for students to immerse themselves in the Costa Rican culture. As part of a family, they will practice speaking Spanish every day and at the same time learn first-hand about the Costa Rican way of life.





## COSTA RICAN HOME



CRLA is located in a quiet, residential / commercial neighborhood area close to downtown San José and our homestays are located in nearby residential neighborhoods. Most of the host families live within a short 15 to 20-minute bus ride from the school.

Our host families have clean, secure, comfortable homes. While students may not find all the luxury of a hotel room, homestays will give them a warm and caring environment that they will not find elsewhere. It will also provide students with the opportunity to practice their Spanish as much as they want!

#### **Host Family Selection**

Our homestay families are carefully selected for their hospitality, friendliness and warmth. They all offer clean lodging in safe neighborhoods. CRLA's homestay coordinators visit each family and get to know them personally. We also ask students to evaluate their homestay experience before they leave to ensure that families constantly provide quality service.

There are many different types of families: with or without children, married couples, single parents, young or older, etc.

The most important quality we consider when choosing a host family is that they are genuinely interested and excited about hosting a foreign student and sharing their home and culture.

## Program

#### Room

Students live in a Costa Rican home where they'll have their own private bedroom. In case they are traveling together, we can also accommodate couples, friends and family in the same homestay, either in shared or separate rooms.



### Meals

Our Costa Rican homestay families will provide students with two daily meals: breakfast and dinner.

#### **Special Diets**

If students are vegetarians, or have any food allergies or other special dietary requirements, the host family will gladly accommodate them.



#### **Laundry Services**

Host families provide laundry service and a weekly change of bedclothes.

## Cultural & Social

### Latin Dance Classes

Students learn to dance like Latins with our daily dance lessons. We teach Salsa, Merengue, Cumbia, Bolero and the latest rhythms.



### Cooking Classes

Students learn to prepare authentic Costa Rican cuisine. Cooking classes are offered every week for approximately two hours. These classes are taught completely in Spanish and they help students enrich their vocabulary, experiment with exotic recipes and enjoy the many tropical fruits and vegetables Costa Rica has to offer.



#### **EXTRA CONVERSATION SESSIONS**

Students can improve their oral skills with our extra "Conversation Hour" held twice a week. They get the opportunity to learn about our culture, share experiences and practice speaking Spanish. Students may grab a fresh cup of coffee and sit in a relaxed atmosphere with one of our Spanish instructors to learn new vocabulary and discuss various topics such as current events and cultural issues.

### Internship Program

CRLA offers an opportunity for students, professionals, researchers, and other individuals with specific areas of interest or enterprise to gain career-related work experience.

This is a unique way to experience the country and practice Spanish while working side-by-side with Costa Ricans.

A few options are available for interns with basic Spanish skills; however, most applicants should have at least an intermediate Spanish level. Therefore, students are required to study for a minimum of two weeks in CRLA's Spanish program before starting their internship.

Internship opportunities include: tourism, ecology, social work, education, business, marketing, law, and health services, among others.

### Spanish and Sports Programs

Students can study Spanish and then learn and practice water sports while in Costa Rica.

These programs combine 2 weeks of Spanish classes at CRLA followed by 2 weeks of surfing, kite-surfing or diving in the Pacific coast.



CRLA is located in San José, the capital of Costa Rica. 











